

# More Than a Food Pantry....

# **Community Garden at AMITA Health Resurrection Medical Center**

In 2018, the hospital provided a piece of land so that a community garden could be planted. Members of the Community Leadership Board of AMITA Health worked with Boy Scout Troop 626. Crops include tomatoes, onions, squash, green beans, eggplant, carrots, beets, radishes, zucchini, cucumbers, etc. Additionally, the pantry is supported by community gardens at Edgebrook Lutheran Church and Union Ridge School.





# **Backpack & School Supply Program**

Backpacks filled with school supplies are given out during the month of August to children to prepare them for the new academic year. Food pantry volunteers work to make sure the backpacks are filled with items the students will need.



# **Kids Summer Feeding Program**

Many children did not have access to food over the summer. With this in mind, we partnered with The Greater Chicago Food Depository (GCFD), AMITA Health Resurrection Medical Center and Union Ridge School to provide children with healthy lunches during the months of June-August. The program is located at Union Ridge School and is OPEN to anyone 18 and under.



# **Special Holiday Distributions**

During the months of November and December, the pantry provides additional food distributions—one for Thanksgiving, and one for Christmas. For Christmas, parents may select toys for their children through the Toyland program. Additionally, in the spring, volunteers work hard to assemble spring

baskets for families. We see many smiling faces as a result of the efforts of our volunteers!



# **Delivery Program**
